Re: Alucobond recycling

Alucobond is a composite material that is composed of aluminum sheets that “sandwich” a plastic core. During fabrication, KPS collects all crop material for recycling.

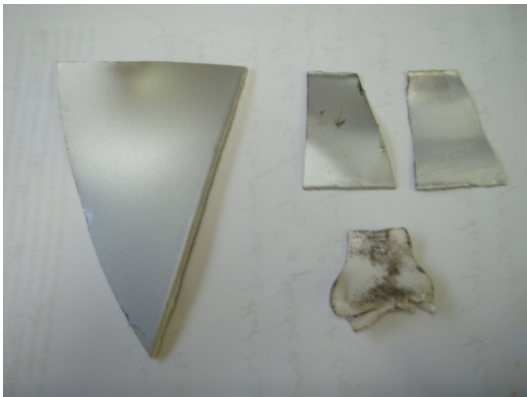


Figure 1: Separation of aluminum skin from plastic core

The recycling process for the unused material begins with the off-cuts being brought to us at Pacific Metals. We package the Alucobond to be sent for further processing. The recycling begins with the material being super-heated which softens the plastic core. This allows the aluminum to be separated from the plastic. Once the aluminum and plastic are sorted they are individually recycled. The aluminum is used for the manufacture of post-consumer recycled aluminum based products and the plastic is used for manufacture of non-food grade plastic based products. Figure 1 is a photograph that shows the separation of the two materials.
